THE VILLAGE STROLL

This pleasant easy walk, gives the walker a good overview of Pettigo and Tullyhommon and is the first x-border trail in Ireland!

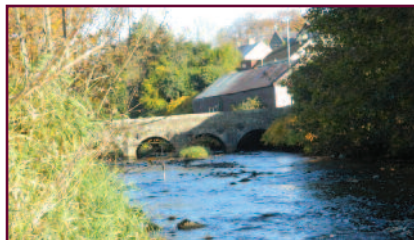
Walk Directions:

A – B Leaving the car park to the front of the Termon Centre the route crosses the road. Turning right, follow the footpath along the river to the iconic new footbridge leading from Co. Donegal into Co. Fermanagh. Turn left back towards the Village taking the first road on your right.

B – C Walking up through Tullyhommon passing the Crimean War Tree the stroll continues straight uphill giving great views over the village and the surrounding countryside before descending down to a T-junction .

C – D Turning left the country road leads past the Mill crossing the Termon river via the Mill bridge you have now crossed the border again! Turning left to find the War Memorial Statue affectionately known as ‘The Quiet Man’!

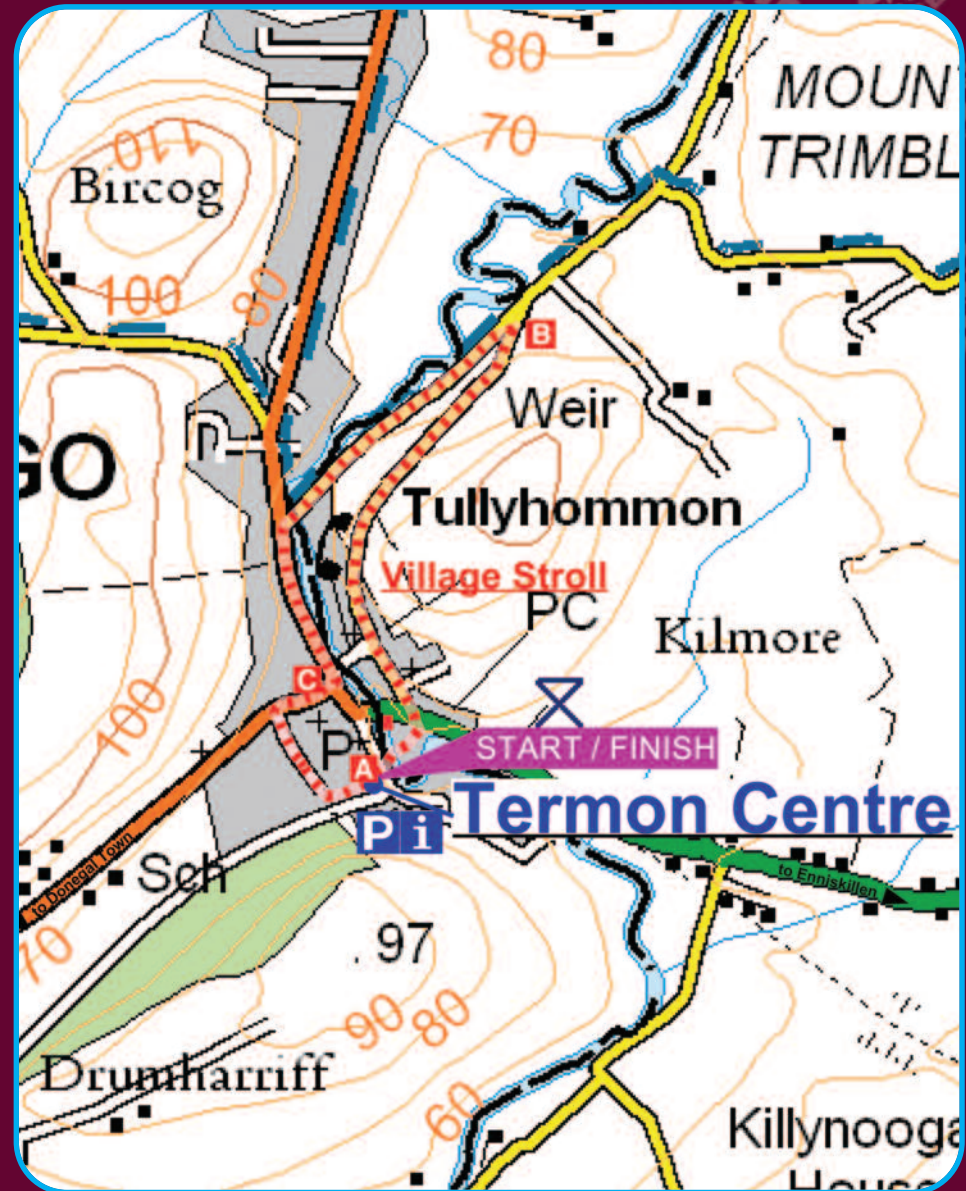
D – A Turning right up Main St, cross the road at Miler’s Restaurant following the alleyway down to the Community Gardens. Turning left the stroll finishes back at the Termon Centre car park.
